Re: Country of Origin Labeling (C.O.O.L.)

Dear valued customer,

As of September 30th 2008, the USDA's mandatory country of origin label regulations went into effect. This is an update to the old law which covered fish and shellfish. This new portion of the law requires, among other things, that the following commodities be labeled with the country of origin.

1. **Meats (Including: Beef, Veal, Lamb, Pork, Goat Meat and Chicken)**
2. **Perishable Agricultural Commodities**
3. **Peanuts, Pecans, Macadamia Nuts and Ginseng**

In order to comply with the new regulations, Plymouth Poultry will be adding the country of origin information to our invoicing for all covered commodities. This will aid Plymouth Poultry and our customers in meeting the recordkeeping requirements of the USDA countries of origin labeling program.

We have done our best to ensure the accuracy of this information and will continue to do so. However, if there are inconsistencies in this information, please alert us so that we may make the necessary corrections.
